NOVATO ART, WINE & MUSIC FESTIVAL DOWNTOWN NOVATO JUNE 10 & 11, 2023

Welcome to the 39th year of one of the North Bay Area's great all around events. This event continues to be very successful for our vendors. The event will be again located on the west side of Grant & Redwood.

Show hours are **11am** – 7pm Saturday, and **11am** – 6pm on Sunday. If you are not in your booth by **9am** Saturday it may be reassigned and forfeit. This show is located in downtown Novato on Grant Ave. between Redwood & 7th, so you can generally drive very close to your space for unloading **provided you are on time**. Please make an extra effort *not to block the streets...we must have a lane to get through the event* during setup and teardown.

You may not use awnings/signage that sticks out into the 20' fire lane on your storefront. Many of the booths have extra space in the rear or on the side which you can use if you wish.

You may begin setting up as early as you need to Saturday morning. Please clear your vehicles from the street as soon as you can. After unloading, park your vehicle and return to your booth to setup. Please keep your unload time to 30 minutes, if possible. We will finish marking about 10pm Friday, but there is no security Friday night.

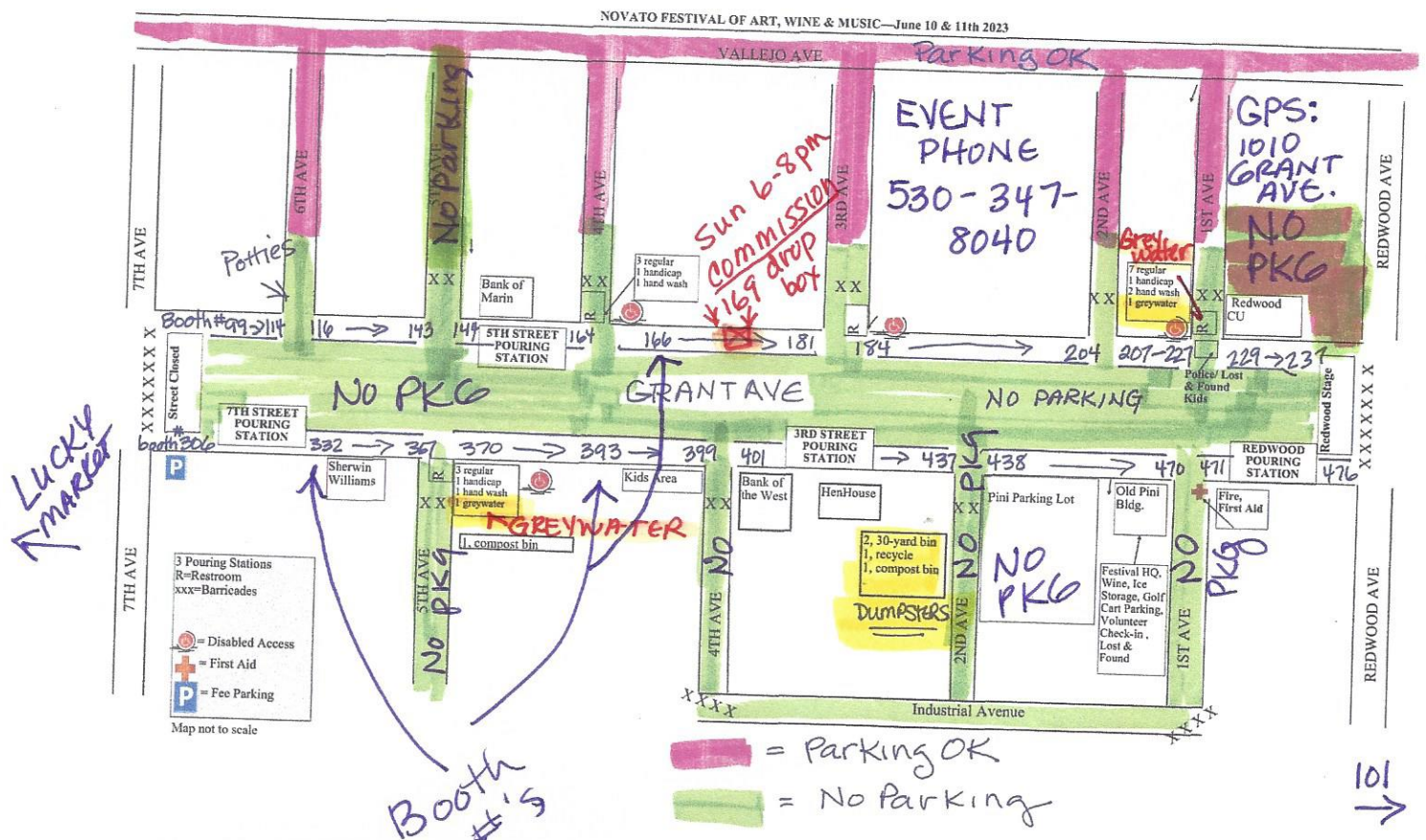
Please be extra careful not to damage the trees. The city has also asked us not to use duct tape at the show site. This street has lots of trees so allow extra time. *If you cannot fit in your booth space due to tree branches please call 530-347-8040 and we will assist you.*

You may not bring your vehicles in to load out Sunday until 6:30pm. Please do not come in before that, and use common sense regarding bringing a vehicle in when there is a lot of patrons still walking around. We cannot be everywhere all at once, so please, please do as you are asked on this.

Parking: **SEE MAP**. You may park on the city side streets *in some parts on the NORTH SIDE* only of the venue, **NOT ON GRANT OR THE FIRST 100 FEET OF EACH INTERSECTION, AND NOT ON 5TH AT ALL**, but within the closed area of the show site in places where there are no booths or equipment going in, provided you do not need to move your vehicle during the event. You may not park in the Town & Country lot, the Redwood Credit Union lot, Citibank or in the old Pini Hardware Lot (Prado group lot) that is across from Marvin's Restaurant (good omelets folks!). **Display your parking pass in your window, and write your booth# on it** if you can so we can locate you if there is a problem. There is also ample regular parking surrounding the event. You must comply with normal city requirements of any parking space you choose, ie. if your vehicle is long you cannot stick way out into the street, or block driveways, etc. We still need a 20' fire lane everywhere.

COMMISSIONS: Commissions will be collected Sunday from 6pm-8pm at the corner of 4th & Grant on the North side of the street on the sidewalk across from the Kettlecorn vendor by **space 169 (see map)**. Look for neon green table cloth/drop box. ***EVERYONE should turn in their commission at the show. Call us if you cannot find us (530) 347-8040.***
